PARSHA SUMMARY

Parshat Emor begins with special mitzvot related to the kohanim, including the rule that they are not allowed to become tamei (impure) through touching a dead body, and the requirement of the rest of the Jewish people to honor the kohanim. The Torah also introduces the ideas of kiddush Hashem and chillul Hashem (sanctifying Hashem's Name and desecrating His Name) in the parshah. In the second half of the parshah, the Torah lists all the

Jewish holidays and their mitzvot. These include Shabbat and not doing forbidden work, Pesach and eating matzah, Rosh Hashanah and blowing the shofar, and Sukkot and sitting in the sukkah and shaking the lulav.
