Herzog's new curriculum "**Tanakh Is Our Story**" uses cutting-edge pedagogical techniques around storytelling to bring the Exodus story to life.



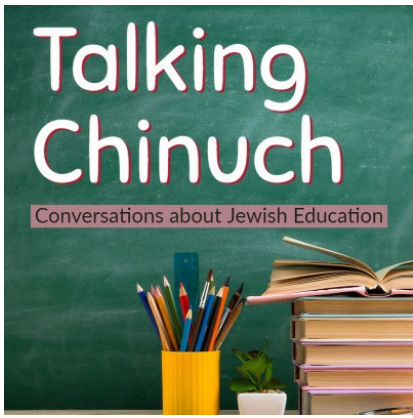
