Sample Lesson Plan: Learning Gratitude from the Plagues (Story 4 Unit 3)



As part of the Unit exploring how the plagues forged part of the Israelites' emerging identity, we offer you a worksheet on the value of gratitude which the commentators explain from the way the plagues of blood, frog and lice were inflicted on the Egyptians. Students can explore this interactive graphic and answer the questions that it raises.

A downloadable worksheet introduces the verses in Exodus Chapters 7 & 8, describing the first three plagues and Rashi's commentary, to prepare students to answer questions about the theme of gratitude and the value of gratitude in their own lives.
